4. SCAFFOLDED ORAL REVIEW:

Ex: Q&A using yes/no questions; either or questions; providing the learners with more

content focus/key words: repetitions of the oral language is the key.

5. SHARED WRITING:

STRATEGY:

Inviting learners to notice things about the language for them selves and share their ideas and questions with the class.

6. SHARED READING: Ex: Choral reading and chunk by chunk decoding of

words and sentences based on MICHIF pattern

(not English).

7. STUDENT APPLICATION AND FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT:

STUDENT APPLICATION: Create own family tree. Tell two other learners about it and

ask the two other learners about theirs.

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT: Watch and listen during application; do a "quick quiz"

STUDENT FEEDBACK: Read student reflections (Not on first day)
